AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND SIGN CONTRACTS WITH THE PLEASANT TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES FOR AN AGREEMENT TO EXTEND FIRE PROTECTION TO DESIGNATED AREAS IN UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF PLEASANT TOWNSHIP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Judiciary and Annexation Committee met on December 10, 2018, and determined that the City enter into negotiations with the Pleasant Township Trustees for the extension of Fire Protection by the City of Van Wert Fire Department and to sign any contracts that stem from those negotiations; and

WHEREAS, City deems that negotiating contracts for extension of Fire Protection to unincorporated portions of Pleasant Township within and around the City of Van Wert are in the people's best interest and that the extension of Fire Protection to those areas can create an additional revenue stream; and

WHEREAS, the Safety-Service Director is in the best position to negotiate and sign any contracts involving any extension of Fire Protection Services by the City of Van Wert Fire Department.

Be it **ORDAINED**, by the Council of the City of Van Wert, Van Wert County, Ohio, with three-fourths of all members concurring, to wit:

Section 1. That the Safety-Service Director is authorized to negotiate and sign contracts on behalf of the City of Van Wert for the extension of Fire Protection to unincorporated areas of Pleasant Township by the City of Van Wert Fire Department.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City; and that said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage by City Council and approval by the Mayor.
